Game Day Notes

- Coppin State returns to non-conference play against Oklahoma after opening Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference play with an 86-82 loss to cross-town rival Morgan State on Wednesday
- This will mark the 12th meeting between the Sooners and the Eagles with OU having won all 11 previous meetings
- Oklahoma head coach Jeff Capel and Coppin State head coach Ron Mitchell have never met on the basketball floor
- Tywain McKee is averaging 25.5 points per game in the Eagles two victories this season and shooting 54.3 (19-35) percent from the floor
- Coppin State was selected fourth in the MEAC preseason poll behind Delaware State, Norfolk State and Florida A&M
- Junior Tywain McKee was a preseason First Team All-MEAC selection after averaging 15.4 points per game last year
- McKee reached double figures in scoring in each of the first nine games and in 32 of the last 34 overall
- Junior Darryl Roberts is averaging 12.8 points per game in the last four games
- Junior Robert Pressey is shooting 58.3 (15-26) percent from the floor in the last four games

Eagles Drop Conference Opener to Morgan State

Boubacar Coly hit the game-winning basket with 25 seconds remaining lifting Morgan State to an 86-82 victory over Coppin State in the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference opener for both schools at Hill Field House. Ruben Britt gave the Eagles an 82-81 lead with 1:57 to play on a three-pointer capping a furious CSU rally from 11 points down in the second half. Ronald Timus, who led the Bears with 19 points, missed an opportunity to put Morgan State back in front when he missed two free throws with 1:14 to play. Tywain McKee was called for an offensive foul on the Eagles next possession and Coly then hit the game-winning basket on a short fall-away jumper. Joseph McLean sealed the victory for the Bears by making three of four free throws down the stretch. Morgan State defeated Coppin State for only the second time in the last 15 meetings and defeated the Eagles in Hill Field House for the first time since a 58-57 victory on Dec. 18, 1999. McKee led the Eagles with 26 points, while Antwan Harrison scored a career-high 16 and Robert Pressey added a career-best 13 points.

OU, Oh No

Oklahoma has dominated the all-time series against Coppin State winning the previous 11 meetings. Additionally, the stingy Sooner defense has not allowed the Eagles to top 50 points in any of the previous five meetings and held Coppin State to a school-record low of nine points in the first half of last season's 57-47 victory. The Sooners are also responsible for the worst loss in Coppin State history when OU defeated the Eagles 103-49 on Dec. 16, 2000. The average margin of victory in the 11 games is 22.0 points.

The Last Time They Met

Kevin Bookout and Taj Gray combined for 37 points and No. 8 Oklahoma held off a furious Coppin State second-half rally to defeat the Eagles 57-47 in the Lloyd Noble Center in Norman, Okla. The Sooner big men combined to score 15 points in the first half as OU raced out to a 28-9 lead at halftime. Sophomore Tywain McKee, who was held scoreless in the first half, exploded for 19 second-half points as the Eagles (0-7) trimmed a 25-point lead to eight late in the final period. Oklahoma (5-1) limited CSU to 18.8 percent shooting from the floor in the first half as the Eagles converted only 3-of-16 attempts. The

Sooners jumped out to a quick 5-0 lead in the first half before Darryl Roberts scored six straight points giving Coppin State a 6-5 lead with 15:07 remaining in the half. Oklahoma held the Eagles scoreless over the next 8:10 of the half and used a 15-0 run to break the game wide open. After Antwan Harrison broke the drought with a jumper with 7:57 remaining CSU would convert only a single free throw the rest of the half as OU held a 28-9 lead at the break. The Sooners were well on their way in the second period before McKee found his shooting touch. A Nate Carter layup gave OU its largest lead of the game at 42-17 with 13:37 remaining. McKee drained a three-pointer on the Eagles next trip and would score eight of the next 16 points for CSU. Augustine Woodlin converted a three-pointer with 8:04 to play, which trimmed the lead to 44-30. McKee nailed a jumper with 6:10 remaining that cut the OU lead to 48-36. CSU would eventually slice the lead to 55-47 with :34 remaining. McKee was joined in double figures by Roberts (11) and Woodlin (10).

Versus the Big 12

Coppin State is 1-30 all-time, including 0-2 this season, against the Big 12 Conference in its current configuration. The Eagles lone victory came against Missouri in 1997, the year after CSU made its last NCAA Tournament appearance. Coppin State has dropped decisions to Big 12 members Kansas State (68-57) and Missouri (98-77) this season.

McKee Continues to Shine

Junior Tywain McKee has gotten off to a fast start in 2006-07 and leads the Eagles, and the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference, averaging 21.0 points per game. He has reached double figures in scoring in all nine games with a high of 31 against La Salle. He also ranks among the MEAC leaders in rebounding, assists, free throw percentage, steals, three-point field goals made and minutes played. McKee scored 19 points against Oklahoma last season, all of them coming in the second half.

The Eagle Trio

Since moving into the starting lineup in the third game of the season against Tennessee the trio of Antwan Harrison, Darryl Roberts and Robert Pressey have each elevated their games. Harrison is averaging 10.3 points and 3.6 rebounds while shooting 56.0 (28-50) percent from the floor as a starter. He has topped his career scoring high in three of the last four games including a career-best 16 points in the Eagles last game against Morgan State. Roberts is averaging 9.7 points, 3.3 assists and 2.6 rebounds per game in the last seven. He also is shooting 40.0 (6-15) percent from the three-point line and 85.7 (12-14) from the free throw line. Pressey is shooting 52.3 (23-44) percent from the floor in his seven starts and averaging 7.0 points, 4.9 rebounds and 1.3 blocked shots per game. He posted a career-best 13 points on Wednesday against Morgan State.

Eagles Picked Fourth in Preseason Poll

The Coppin State men's basketball team has been selected to finish fourth in the 2006-07 Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference preseason poll as selected by the league head coaches and sports information directors.

The Eagles received 196 points and finished behind Delaware State, Norfolk State and Florida A&M. Delaware State, which has won the last two regular-season titles, was chosen as the favorite after receiving all 14 first-place votes and 308 points.

Junior Tywain McKee was selected as a member of the preseason first team and was joined by Jahsha Bluntt of Delaware State, Tony Murphy of Norfolk State, Brian Mason of South Carolina State and Jason Wills of North Carolina A&T.

Coppin State compiled a 12-18 overall record last season and finished second in the regular season with a 12-6 conference record.

McKee was named the MEAC Rookie of the Year in addition to earning second team all-conference honors last season. The Philadelphia native averaged a team-best 15.4 points per game and also averaged 4.2 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 1.6 steals per game.
